

Module Overview

This Module is built around ten basic digital skills. Specifically, it includes the distinction between "Hardware" and "Software" in order to provide an overview of the basic parts of the computer. Another basic subject is "Windows" which aims to present the most common operating system in Europe which is integrated into most computers. Other sections include the "Peripheral devices" about data storage offline and the "Internet" related to data storage online along with the use of browsers (Google Chrome in particular). Concerning the content creation there is a section about "Working with Documents" which explains the use of free Google Drive and Google Docs. Additionally, there is content related to the use of tools for communication, access to news and groups of common interest, such as "Skype" and "Facebook". Lastly, there is a section on "Google Translate" concerning the translation of useful texts in different languages and "Google Maps" which allows you to navigate in an unfamiliar environment.

Scope

The Basic Computer Skills Module aims to present basic knowledge of computer handling - from installing and working using with different types of documents to geographical orientation in the local environment, and communicating with relatives and institutions.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of this Module you should be able to:

- Recognize the basic elements of Hardware on computer, so if you need to change parts of it and to build it.
- Install the required software and perform basic functions with it.
- Perform basic Windows functions.
- Recognize the basic types of peripheral devices and how to deal with them.
- Use the internet to search for useful information.
- Work with different types of documents.
- Communicate via Skype.
- Communicate via Facebook
- Translate content from the local language into your language through Google Translate.
- Use Google maps to find addresses and to use public transportation.

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Module Overview

Labour market and its rules and regulation are different in every European country. Generally the national political authority set up agencies or offices in order to give out information and to offer practical tools about how and where to look for a job. Some tools are however fundamental and need to be known no matter which country the learner is living in. This module deals with the CV structure, the meaning of its parts and how to convert your story into a presentation likely to be attractive for the labour market. Strictly connected to the CV is the vocabulary about the labour market which is also included and how to manage a job interview. Lastly, at the end of the module you will learn about the Eures portal which is a useful database about the European labour market

Scope

The module is about the labour market in Europe and the fundamental things you need to know in order to enter it. You will learn what documents you need if you want to look for a job, how to write a CV, where to look for a job and how to manage a job interview.





Rights- Holidays, Leave & Day off



Sick pay

If you are sick you have the right to stay home and to take care of yourself. If you miss some working days but you can prove that you were sick, you have the right to be payed. To prove it you will need to take a medical certification when you come back to work. While you are home the occupational doctor can visit you without notice to check if you are actually sick.



Maternity leave

If you are a pregnant woman you also have a maternity leave (usually some months before the childbirth and some months after). In both cases (sickness and maternity) your are not going to lose your job.



Holiday

You have the right to take some paid time off work during the year. It can mean either some days that you choose or a public holiday. Public holidays are already established; the holidays you choose are up to you, you simply have to agree those days off with your boss. The number of holidays that are due to you depend on your working contract.

Also, another right as an employee is to get some time off work either because you need some rest or because you are experiencing health issues.









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Module Overview

This module will present the basic legal framework in which all rights and obligations are safeguarded. In particular, it will describe and outline some main European laws, regulations and directives so that the beneficiaries can be aware of their rights and obligations with respect to the access to employment and social security as well as the access to education and healthcare.

Scope

The module "Know your laws" will describe the legal framework and the main laws, directives and regulations applied in the EU which can be a guideline for you when practicing your right to employment and social security as well as to education and healthcare. It includes basic legal texts explaining the way you can safeguard your rights and contribute to the social inclusion process in the host societies.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of this Module you should be able to:

- Recognize the legal context as well as the policies at European level regarding the access to employment and social security as well as the access to education and healthcare.

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


Starting Up a New Business

Launching a successful business requires an awareness of one's knowledge, skills, abilities, aptitudes, values and preferences! It is more likely to thrive in something that you are good at.





The business plan should consist of the following components

- title page (name proposed for the business, entrepreneur's name, contact address and other co-ordinates)
- summary of business objectives
- table of contents
- structure of the proposed business
- intended product or service that is to be sold
- marketing plan (based on a simple market survey)
- financial plan
- anticipated returns
- other supporting documents, such as letters of education and training, community service documents, etc.

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
