Overview

Europe is facing new challenges with the arrival of high number of migrants, refugees and asylum seekers during the last years. The project partners of Digital Inclusion will collaborate for the better integration of these people in the labour markets and the European societies, developing adult educators' competences to respond efficiently to the needs of diversified groups of learners and to utilize new technologies for better outreach and teaching outcomes.



Objectives

The project Digital Inclusion aims to:

- strengthen the cooperation and networking between organisations from countries most affected by the refugees' crisis;
- test and implement innovative practices in the field of education and training of specific target groups;
- better prepare and deploy the education and training of professionals for equity, diversity and inclusion challenges in the learning environment;
- promote the integration of refugees, asylum seekers and newly arrived migrants through enhancing their basic skills and key competences for achieving better social and labour inclusion in the European Community;
- encourage the utilization of Open Educational Resources (OERs) to provide digital training tools and give access to education to migrants, refugees and asylum seekers.

Activities

The proposed action will promote and use the potential of OERs to provide digital access to education and training and digital tools for social inclusion in partner countries and abroad.

The following activities are included:

- Development of e-learning course, available in 6 languages
- Trainings for migrants/refugees/asylum seekers in 6 EU countries
- Creation of network for cross-border cooperation
- Regional dissemination conferences
- International Multiplier Forum
