* The Foundation Golinelli was born in Bologna in 1988 by the will of the entrepreneur and philanthropist, Mr. Marino Golinelli.

Today it is a unique example in Italy of full operating private foundation investing on cultural and responsible development of the citizens in all fields of knowledge.

One of the most important strategic goals is to provide children (especially school age, starting from an early age) skills and tools that enable them to grow responsibly, civilly and socially, fostering ethical behavior to build a more integrated society.

Young people, the future citizens of tomorrow, can develop in an innovative and competitive way also in the professional fields, in an increasingly globalized, complex, multicultural and unpredictable world.

Large part of the training, educational and cultural activities of the Golinelli Foundation takes place at the Opificio Golinelli, opened on 3 October 2015. This citadel for knowledge and culture, which required a total investment of 12 million euros by its founder Marino Golinelli, counts on an area of 9,000 square meters and it expects to welcome more than 150,000 visitors a year.

Such expected numbers and the revolutionary cultural model, unique in Italy, makes it a center of national and international relevance, as well as a pride and an extraordinary opportunity for the city of Bologna and the future of its young generations.
