### CRITERIOS DE CALIFICACIÓN Y VALORACIÓN

*El examen consiste de las siguientes secciones:*

- **Grammar and vocabulary: (35 preguntas X 2 puntos cada una = 70 puntos.)**
  - Hay tres preguntas de reserva que el candidato debe realizar por si fuera necesario anular alguna de las preguntas del examen. Las de reserva serían usadas para la corrección en el orden exacto en el que aparecen.
  - Sólo se puede marcar una respuesta de cada pregunta, marcar más de una supone anular la pregunta, cada respuesta incorrecta se penaliza con un -2, Las preguntas no respondidas no penalizan.
- **Reading section (5 preguntas x 2 puntos = 10 puntos)**
  - El candidato debe responder preguntas sobre un texto con frases completas y usando sus propias palabras.
  - Cada error gramatical, falta de ortografía, mala colocación de las palabras...se penalizará con -1 punto.
- **Writing section (10 puntos.)**
  - Las rúbricas para la corrección de la prueba son las siguientes:
    - Grammar 25%
    - Use of English 25%
    - Coherence of the topic 25%
    - Structure of the text, cohesion and use of linkers 25%.
  - Cada error gramatical, falta de ortografía, mala colocación de las palabras...se penalizará con -1 punto.
- **Listening (5 preguntas x 2 puntos = 10 puntos.)**
  - Hay cuatro respuestas para elegir sólo una, marcar más de una respuesta invalida la pregunta. Cada pregunta incorrecta se penaliza con -2 puntos. Las preguntas sin responder no penalizan.

**El candidato debe hacer todas las partes y debe obtener una media de 3 en cada una de ellas para poder hacer media y superar la prueba. La nota total debe ser igual o superior a 5.**
